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DAY 1 – 23rd March 2022

After verifying that all the partners were online and correctly connected the Meeting started at 10.45 a.m. GESEME and the Municipality of Pegeia couldn't connect.

Mario Bozzo Costa from EFA started with presenting the draft of the report of the IO2 with an index of the activities the partnership did and the results that were achieved. Almost everything is good and ready, we just have some activity with no data because the partnership is finishing to work on them: supplementary and online modules and final test; production of motivational videos with QR code; settlement of validation model for street coaches' skills.

Then he specified that IO2 is a strict link between IO1 and IO3. In it we had 2 work packages, WP3 and WP4 on which the partnership worked. He also added that we can try to find and evaluate the steps needed for the recognition of the competencies to validate the figure.

Then we did an excursus of all the activities of the IO2 that we have in the report:

WP3: A1 – setting competencies; A2 – training courses for the trainers (we created 16 modules); A3 – online training for new coaches (that needs to be finalised); A4 – test of indoor/outdoor experimentation of training courses; A5 – supplementary and online training modules and final test (that needs to be finalised);

WP4: A6 – street track&field learning path for children; A7 – motivational video (that needs to be finalised); A8 – selection of young target group (in progress), A9 – (implementation of 2 experimental paths for young groups (in progress), A10 – settlement of validation of street coaches' skills (to do).

Mario Bozzo Costa also specified that the validation of the working figure is up to each partner, we have just to create the guidelines of the competences for this figure of the street coach educator that right now doesn't exist. He also agreed with the polish partner (Collegium Balticum) to stay in contact to cooperate on a final review of the IO2 and for the final graphical aspects of the report.

After that the partners who did the experimentation on the educational path presented their activities (we had 3 partners who were able to do it): Laura Faveto from Trionfo Ligure started and explained first how they put together the course for the trainers: it was both online and in presence. The online parts were the ones more theoretical: healthy lifestyle, safety and prevention, street education; the part in presence were the ones about athletics that were done in Villa Gentile (Genoa, Italy) and during which we created some videos with exercises to propose and we had some ideas on how to transfer athletics in a non-formal situation using the street as our field. Then she told the partners about the different path they are following with the target groups of youngsters: one with a group of immigrant women linked to the association Migrantes in Genoa; one with a group on unaccompanied minors coming from a community and a third group that we approach cooperating with an educational centre that does street education in a part of the city. In this last case we use the centre as our link with the youngsters, so our instructors do the work in direct cooperation with the educators of the centre.

Then Enis Ozdemir from IZGEM explained us that they were able to do a good training for the trainers with the targets they selected, with a lot of participants and they were satisfied with the output of the course. They were also able to transport it in activities with groups of youngsters and the activities are





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working well with immigrants and refugees that entered in contact with them. He wasn't able to give us more details because he wasn't in direct contact with the trainers and educators, but he knows that the activities are working well.

Then Calin Rus from IIT told us that they were able to do a course with trainers that was satisfying for both parties, and after that they started working with different disadvantaged groups in different disadvantaged areas near Timisoara in which they were already present with some other activities and volunteers. They are also trying to do an experimentation with one of the trainers that participates in the course in a school in which she works that is in direct contact with one of the disadvantaged realities they are working with (a community of Roma). They also have some other activities in progress in different other areas near Timisoara in which they are trying this experimentation.

After a brief sum up of the day the session ended at 1 p.m.

Day 2 – 24th March 2022

After checking that we were all present, at 10 a.m. We went to do the study visit in a school in a village near Timisoara in which we were invited to see the activities one of the participants to the training for the trainers is doing with the children that are going to the primary school. She showed us a complete lesson during which she proposed different kind of exercises using some tools to have the children do some path of dexterity and some cooperating games in which they had to be fast and think fast in cooperation with one another. After that we went to visit the village from which some of the kids of the school come from. At 12.30 we ended the visit.

In the afternoon we started the session at 2 pm after checking that we had everyone connected online. Laura Faveto from Trionfo Ligure started by describing to the partners how the IO3 is composed and the tools we would like to use to collect the contributions of the partners to di the final product of the project: the guidelines. First, she showed the main objective of the IO3, that is to valorise all the previous results and implements new models for the participation development of young people. It supports the activation of new coach path with a synergic relationship with education centres. Then she went with the partners through the specific objectives of the IO, that are to improve what was already done and to disseminate as much as possible the results and all the innovative aspects of the educational path. Then we passed at the structure of the IO that is divided in 2 work packages, WP5 and WP6, that we will try to put together with all the partners using some tools such as questionnaires, interviews, focus groups. Laura Faveto also showed the partners the timeline with all the next activities, events and meetings so that the planning is clear to everyone. She also specified that our main and final goal is to create the guidelines for the realisation of track&field path in the streets.

Then Calin Rus from IIT observed that it is important to decide how we want to construct and create the guidelines so that all the partners can give their contribution in the most useful way, and also to be specific about the target for these guidelines. About this point Laura Faveto proposed to do a Skype Call in the next weeks so that everyone can think a bit about what we discussed, and we will be able to create in a more detailed way all the next steps and activities. All the partners agreed, and Laura Faveto





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said that she will create a doodle to decide a date suitable for all. He also suggested to pay attention to the language we will use to define some specifics so that all the recipients of the guidelines have a clear view, and we won't incur into misunderstandings.

Then Laura Faveto updated the partners on the motivational video, saying that Trionfo Figure is trying to contact some of the best Italian Track&field athletes and they are waiting for the answers from the Federation. She also remembered all the partners that they also have to interview some people from the athletic world of their country and they have to do the translation so that the video can be subtitled and then associated to a QR code that each one of us can put in the locations where the activities take place.

Then Laura Faveto passed to describe the state of art of the project talking about what we already did and what we have to do. We completed the IO1, IO2 (almost finished), event 1, TM1, TM2, TM3, TM4; we have in progress the last straw of IO2; we have to do TM5, TM6, event 2, IO3, multiplier event. She asked Tjasa Kozjan from DRPDNM if it will be possible for them to do the event 2 in Novo Mesto in June as planned on the new timeline and she told us that she is positive. Then it was asked to Eniz Ozdemir from IZGEM if it will be possible to do the TM5 in Izmir in July and it was also positive. He agreed to create a doodle to find the dates that will be suitable for all the partners.

Then Laura Faveto told the partners about the improvement of the IG and FB pages of the project, and she also asked all the partnership to send photos and links of their activities and to publicise the pages so that we can continue to improve.

After that Laura Faveto gave some indications that Mariangela Bastone from EFA, who wasn't able to connect with us, left on the financial aspects. She received all the documentation till December from Turkey (IZGEM) and Spain (GESEME), so she asked to all the partners to send her all the documentation till March 2022, so that she can collect all the documentation on IO2. We will live the IO3 for the final reporting. She also gave a list of all the activities reportable till March 2022 so that it is clear for everyone. Tjasa Kozjan told Laura Faveto that she already sent to Mariangela Bastone their documentation, so Laura Faveto told her she will verify and let them know.

After a brief sum up and considering there was nothing else to discuss we closed the meeting at 4.30 pm.

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
